



Day 1 July 24, Monday: Depart USA

Depart New York's JFK International Airport via American Airlines for our overnight transatlantic flight to Paris.

(D,B) Dinner, breakfast and beverages will be served aloft.

Day 2 July 25, Tuesday: Arrival in Paris | Solesmes

Arrive at Paris Charles de Gaulle Airport. Continue through Passport Control then claim our luggage and a Peter's Way tour manager/guide will meet us in the arrivals area. Board our private bus and we will be on our way to the countryside and the Province of Maine. A stop will be made for independent lunch. This afternoon we will arrive in Solesmes and check-in at Grand Hotel de Solesmes (Across the street from the Abbey). Celebrate Mass. The remainder of the afternoon will be at leisure. This evening, walk to the Abbey of Saint Pierre de Solesmes, Mother of the Benedictines in France.

Vespers with the Monks of Solesmes (6:00 – 6:30 pm).

Return to the hotel for dinner.

Dinner and overnight at Grand Hotel de Solesmes.

Day 3 July 26, Wednesday: Solesmes | Fontgombault

Early morning walk to the Abbey Church to experience the fountain of prayer of the Monks of Solesmes singing the chants of our musical heritage. Lauds with the Monks of Solesmes (7:00 – 7:45 am). Return to hotel for breakfast. Afterwards, we will have a guided tour of the Abbey. Meet with the Brothers of Solesmes and view the ancient chant manuscripts. Celebrate Mass. Independent lunch. Late afternoon, depart Solesmes for Fontgombault (2.5 hours). Arrive in time for Vespers.

Vespers with the Benedictine Community of Fontgombault (6:00 – 6:30 pm).

Audience with the Abbot of Fontgombault (subject to confirmation) Dinner and overnight at hotel in Fontgombault area.

Day 4 July 27, Thursday: Fontgombault | Chartres

Lauds (7:00 - 7:45 am) followed by Mass, with the Benedictine Community of Fontgombault. Afterwards, we will have a guided tour of the Benedictine Abbey of Notre Dame of Fontgombault, founded in the 11th century by Pierre de l'Etoile. Benedictine life at the Abbey was interrupted in 1741, and reappeared in 1948 thanks to the monks of the Abbey of Solesmes. Fontgombault is part of this same Benedictine congregation which founded other abbeys such as the Monastery of Randol. This afternoon, board our bus for a scenic drive to Chartres (3 hours). The Cathedral spires of Chartres can be seen from miles away, seeming to rise out of the wheat fields of the Beauce Plains. Check-in at hotel. After dinner at the hotel, transfer to Chartres Cathedral.

Rehearsal (8:00 pm), Concert presented by St. Joseph Seminary Schola, (9:00 pm), Chartres Light Show (10:00 pm).

Overnight at hotel in Chartres. (B,D)

Day 5 July 28, Friday: Chartres | Rouen | Beauvais

Buffet breakfast at hotel. After breakfast enjoy a visit to Notre Dame Cathedral, the jewel in the crown of medieval churches in Europe and a testimony in stone to the religious fervor of the Middle Ages. Chartres Cathedral boasts an unrivaled expanse of sculpture, as well as one of Europe's most impressive collections of stained- glass windows. The Cathedral of Our Lady of Chartres, also houses the Sancta Camisia, a tunic that traditional says belonged to the Blessed Virgin Mary, which will be displayed on Fridays only. After the visit, board our coach for Rouen, the port city of Paris at the mouth of the Seine River on the English Channel. Arrive in time for the 1:00 pm concert series at Rouen Cathedral, presented by St. Joseph Seminary Schola. Independent lunch and time to explore Rouen, packed with lovely churches and marked with reminders of St. Joan of Arc who was burned alive here on May 30, 1431. A modern church and memorial dedicated to Joan, France's patron saint can be visited in the centuries-old market place where she was martyred. We will return to Rouen Cathedral for a closer visit. The Cathedral boasts a strong musical tradition since the Middle Ages. Up until the French Revolution the Cathedral choir was well known for singing from memory. The first major organist was Jean Titelouze. The so-called father of the French organ school occupied the post as titular organist from 1588 - 1633. As we depart Rouen, we will stop to celebrate Mass at the Church of Saint-Etienne-du-Rouvray, where Fr. Jacques Hamel was martyred while celebrating the Eucharist. Late afternoon, continue to Beauvais and visit the Cathedral Sainte-Pierre described as lace of white stone in the highest choir in the world. Check in to our hotel and freshen up for dinner. (B,D)

Overnight at hotel in Beauvais

Day 6 July 29, Saturday: Compiégne | Reims | Paris

Buffet breakfast at hotel. After breakfast, depart Beauvais for Compiegne to visit the Community of Discalced Carmelite Monastery. Visit the monastery and the museum with relics from the Carmelite Martyrs of Compiégne. Prayer and reflection at the Carmelite Monastery. Next, we will go to the Church of Saint Jacques. St. Joan of Arc came to pray at this location in 1430. Our journey continues to Reims with a stop for independent lunch. This afternoon, visit Reims Cathedral, a masterpiece of Gothic architecture and the site of the coronation of the great kings of France. Here, Clovis was baptized, making France the "Eldest daughter of the Church". Among other kings crowned here were Louis the Pious (son of Charlemagne), Saint Louis, Charles VII (who came here with Joan of Arc), Francis I and Louis XIV. Coronations at the hands of the archbishop signified that the monarchy had divine rights: Royalty did not come from man but from God. The coronation of Charles X in 1825 was the last one in Reims. France would no longer have a sovereign, reason for the end of coronations in Reims. Celebrate Mass at Reims Cathedral, sung by St. Joseph Seminary Schola. Following the visit, we will continue to Paris. Upon arrival, check in to the hotel and freshen up for dinner. Dinner at a restaurant in Paris. Overnight at hotel in Paris.

Day 7 July 30, Sunday: Paris

Buffet breakfast at hotel. Day at leisure to enjoy the beautiful churches of Paris. Attend Mass at St. Sulpice (11:00 am). Independent lunch. Enjoy the remainder of the afternoon at leisure in Paris. Churches to visit: Sainte Trinite; St. Clotilde; St. Severin. Attend organ recital at St. Eustache (5:30 pm). Independent dinner. Overnight at hotel in Paris.

Day 8 July 31, Monday: Rue du Bac | St. Vincent de Paul | Sainte-Chapelle | Notre Dame | Cluny Museum

Buffet breakfast at hotel. We will begin our day with a visit to the Chapel of Our Lady of the Miraculous Medal, at Rue du Bac, where our Blessed Mother appeared to St. Catherine Labouré in 1830. Celebrate Mass at Rue du Bac, sung by St. Joseph Seminary Schola. Nearby, we will visit the Shrine of St. Vincent de Paul. In the Chapel of the Vincentian Fathers, see the glass reliquary above the main altar, containing the body of St. Vincent within a sculpted wax figure of the patron saint of charitable societies. Continue on to Ile de la Cité, where you will visit the magnificent cathedral, Notre Dame de Paris. Its massive flying buttresses, famous towers, and elegant rose windows will take your breath away. We visit the Basilica and the relics of the Passion the Crown of Thorns housed in the Notre Dame Basilica. Possible informal recital by St. Joseph's Seminary Schola. End our morning at Sainte Chapelle. The Holy Chapel was built by King Louis XI and is a masterpiece of flamboyant Gothic architecture in the heart of the Palais de la Cité on the Ile de la Cité. Marvel at its unique stained glass windows rendering the air iridescent with light and color, symbols of the heavenly Jerusalem. Independent lunch. This afternoon we will visit Cluny Museum, an outstanding example of civic architecture in medieval Paris. Its was formerly the town house of the abbots of Cluny, started in 1334. The structure was rebuilt by Jacques d'Amboise, abbot of Cluny 1485 - 1510; it combines Gothic and Renaissance elements. In 1843, it was made into a public museum, to hold relics of France's Gothic past preserved in the building. The Museum de Cluny houses a variety of important medieval artifacts. In particular, its tapestry collection, which includes the fifteenth century tapestry cycle La Dame á la Licorne. The museum is home to early medieval sculptures from the seventh and eighth centuries, works of gold and ivory, antique furnishing, stained glass, and illuminated manuscripts.

Day 9 August 1, Tuesday: Versailles | Montmarte | Concert at La Madéléine

Buffet breakfast at hotel. After breakfast, enjoy an excursion to Versailles. Drive along the Seine to Boulogne and Sevres to Versailles, the magnificent palace of the kings of France, which remained the seat of the French monarchy until the fall of Louis XVI and Marie Antoinette. We will have a guided tour of the beautiful apartments, the Hall of Mirrors, Gallery of Battles, the Royal Chapel, and the famous gardens with hundreds of statues, fountains and flowers. End our morning tour at Montmartre, the fascinating Artist Square and Sacré Coeur Basilica, with its huge bell tower and onion-shaped domes. Celebrate Mass at Sacré Coeur Basilica. Independent lunch. Return to hotel to freshen-up. Transfer to the Church of La Madéléine (2:30 pm), Rehearsal (3:00 pm), Concert presentation by St. Joseph Seminary Schola (4:00 pm).

Dinner at a restaurant in Paris.

Overnight at hotel in Paris.

Day 10 August 2, Wednesday: Return to the USA

After breakfast, we will be transferred to Paris Charles de Gaulle International Airport for our return flight to the USA.

Unexpected circumstances may cause changes to the outlined itinerary.

Acceptance of these Terms & Conditions, with signature on enrollment form, is required for participation in this tour.

PAYMENT: Deposits and insurance payments will be accepted in the form of check, money order or credit card. The package pricing reflects a discount of \$100.00 per person for payments made entirely by personal check, money order or certified bank check. The package price is \$100 higher if paid by credit card. If final payment is not received by the balance deadline, Peter's Way Tours reserves the right to cancel your reservation. If for any reason payment is received within 21 days of departure, a charge for express mailing of final documents will apply. A \$50.00 late payment fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for late payments. Personal checks will not be accepted within 30 days of departure. If the bank has returned a personal check, a \$25.00 processing fee will apply and subsequent payments must be made in the form of money order, certified bank check or credit card.

CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS: From the time your deposit is received up to 130 days prior to departure, there is a \$250.00 nonrefundable cancellation fee per person. From 129 to 100 days prior to departure, there is a \$350.00 non refundable cancellation fee per person. From 99 days prior to departure up to the day of departure, there is a nonrefundable cancellation fee of 100% of all payments made per person including departure taxes & fuel surcharges, single supplement, deviation fees, travel insurance payments and any other costs incurred. Travel insurance is offered as protection for cancellations due to medical reasons such as illness or injury, please see TRAVEL INSURANCE. Travel insurance payments are nonrefundable upon receipt. Tour participation is nontransferable. Names cannot be transferred on reservations or airline tickets. Refund requests can only be honored when submitted in writing to Peter's Way Tours. All refund requests are subject to cancellation restrictions as set forth above. No refund will be made for any accommodations or services included in the tour that you do not use.

LATE RESERVATIONS: A \$25.00 late fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for bookings received after the deposit deadline. All space is subject to availability and cannot be guaranteed past the deposit deadline noted on the brochure.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: All participants must have a valid passport. U.S. Passports must be valid for at least **six (6) months**, subsequent to return date. Special entry requirements for non-U.S. citizens may apply. Please consult the appropriate Consulate for current requirements. It is solely the passenger's responsibility to ensure that all documents needed are completed and current. Peter's Way Tours will not be held responsible for lack of current and valid entry documents.

AIR TRANSPORTATION: Round trip from **New York's JFK International Airport on American Airlines.** Flight itinerary and carrier may be subject to change. Departure taxes & fuel surcharges are estimated. They are determined solely by the airlines and are subject to increase prior to ticketing (approximately 30 days prior to departure).

AIRLINE SEATING: Under group airline reservations/contracts, the airlines will provide a block of seats for the group. Individual requests for seating preferences can only be made at time of check-in. Peter's Way cannot submit seating preferences as we cannot guarantee that any or all requests will be honored. If you require specific seating as a condition of your travel, it is suggested that you book your airfare individually and purchase the Land Only package. Upgrades to premium economy, business class, or first class may be available but oftentimes airlines will not allow the upgrades until time of ticketing (approximately 30 days prior to departure). Group reservations may not be accessible online for advance check-in/boarding passes/seat assignments. Airline guidelines vary. Please contact our office for specific details.

LAND ONLY PASSENGERS: Land Only packages do not include any portion of the group airfare. This includes any flights booked within the group itinerary. All airline tickets will be your responsibility to book independently. A passenger choosing the Land Only portion of the package (\$2,795.00 per person sharing a twin room) must notify Peter's Way Tours, in writing, at least 100 days prior to departure or a penalty fee will be assessed. Please be advised, passenger(s) opting for the Land Only package or who are deviating from the group itinerary will be responsible for their own transfers to/from hotel/airport. However, if you arrive at the same time or earlier than your group, you are welcome to join the group on the bus. It is recommended that you purchase your air transportation only after you have been notified that the group has materialized. If you purchase your own air transportation and the group does not materialize or you cancel your package for any reason, Peter's Way Tours will not be held responsible for the cost of your airfare or other arrangements booked independently.

DEVIATIONS & ITINERARY CHANGES: Peter's Way Tours is pleased to assist clients with changes in itineraries. All deviation requests must be submitted in writing at least 90 days prior to departure. Deviation fee will apply plus an airline change fee per person. Your routing and dates requested will determine if a difference in airfare will also apply. Not all carriers permit routing changes and/or deviations from the group itinerary. Please contact our office for information.

TRANSFERS AND PORTERAGE: Round-trip airport transfers are included for passengers who purchase the full air and land package. Porterage of one piece of luggage throughout your tour at hotels is also included.

ACCOMMODATIONS/SINGLE TRAVELERS: Price per person is based on two persons sharing twin bedded rooms with in hotels throughout your tour. Double bedded rooms for married couples are subject to availability and must be requested. Triple rooms may be available for family or friends traveling together. We discourage triple room accommodations because they are normally not spacious and there is no discount for triple occupancy. Triple rooms usually are regular twin or double bedded rooms with a rollaway bed added. Single rooms are limited but may be requested at time of booking for an additional charge of \$650.00. While single rooms provide privacy, they are often smaller than twin bedded rooms and may be located away from the group in some hotels. We will make every effort (if you so desire) to match you with a same gender roommate when we receive your application, but we do not guarantee a roommate can be matched. If a single room must be assigned due to your roommate's cancellation, incompatibility or for any other reason (even at the last moment or while on tour), we must charge you the tour's single supplement or pro-rated amount.

MEALS: Buffet breakfast daily plus seven dinners as per attached itinerary.

GRATUITIES & SERVICE CHARGES: Gratuities are not included in your tour package. For good work, recommended (but voluntary) tipping to your tour manager is 4.00 Euro per passenger per day; to the driver is 2.00 Euro per passenger per day; for the local guides 1.50 Euro per passenger per day. Tips for the tour manager and bus driver are normally given as a group at the end of the tour. Other gratuities are usually handled individually. All service charges and local taxes as imposed by hotels are included in the program rate. Although service charges are included, it is customary to leave 1.00 Euro per person for the waiters after each meal and 1.00 Euro per person per day for the maid/bell boys.

TRAVELER HEALTH ADVISORY: All passengers must ensure that they are medically and physically fit for travel and that such traveling will not endanger themselves or others as our pilgrimages entail a lot of walking, which may involve stairs, hills, cobblestone roads and uneven pavement. Additionally, most motor coaches are not equipped with wheelchair ramps. It is each passenger's responsibility to be aware of his or her limits with regard to travel and group activities. Any person with a disability requiring special attention must advise Peter's Way Tours of the situation at time of enrollment. A qualified companion must accompany any passenger requiring special assistance. Peter's Way Tours will make reasonable attempts to accommodate disabled passengers with special needs, but shall not be held responsible in the event we are unable to do so. Moreover, Peter's Way Tours is not responsible for the denial of services by any carriers, hotels, restaurants, or other independent suppliers.

TRAVEL INSURANCE: It is strongly recommended that all participants purchase insurance when they travel since the tour operator is not responsible for non-refundable payments, damaged luggage or trip interruption. Peter's Way Tours offers an optional Passenger Travel Protection Plan that provides coverage for pre-paid travel arrangements made through Peter's Way Tours. These benefits and pre-paid travel arrangements made through reter's way fours. These benefits and services help insure the well being of the passenger while traveling worldwide. The insurance premium is based on total package price, including taxes, fuel surcharges, single supplements, deviation fees, late charges, etc. The insurance premium for total package prices from \$0 to \$1000.00 is \$100; \$1001.00 to \$2000.00 is \$175; \$2001.00 to \$3000.00 is \$225; \$3001.00 to \$4000.00 is \$250; \$4001.00 to \$5000.00 is \$275; and \$5001.00 and over is 6% of total package price.
